Course Title: American Sign Language I & II

Course Number: 83103 and 83113

Core Area: (CTE)

Course Description: These courses are designed to teach functional ASL which can be used in everyday interactions. Learning these functions will enable students to establish and maintain social relationships with others who use ASL. The grammar and vocabulary of ASL will be learned within the context of communicative activities. Students will be taught basic awareness of the deaf culture through role-play situations, assigned reading, videotapes, and interaction with deaf individuals.

Course Title: Advanced Health Sciences, Essentials of Nutrition and Medical Terminology

Course Number: 83223

Core Area: Health Science & Technology (CTE) (S/M)

Course Description: Concepts of nutrition, physiology, and medical terminology will be used to examine the structure and function of the human body. Topics such as stress management, hypnosis, mental health, substance abuse, pathology, and human reproduction will be explored to help the student develop an understanding of wellness and healthy lifestyles.
